Thomas Henningsen is a true "Kieler Jung" from the north of Germany. He studied Zoologie and Marine Science at the Universities of Kiel and Bremen in Germany, and at Texas A&M in Galveston in the USA.

He lived in Texas and in Peru, where he carried out his research for his diploma- and doctoral thesis on the behaviour ecology of wild bottlenose dolphins in the Gulf of Mexico and the river dolphins in the Amazon.

Since 1991 he has been working for the environmental organisation Greenpeace, where he has taken part and coordinated several national, international and global campaigns for the protection of the marine and forest environment. He is currently the international Campaign Director for Greenpeace Germany.

Thomas Henningsen is specialized in dolphins, whales, fisheries, forests and all environmental issues of Amazonia. He has published several scientific and popular articles, and is the author of a 13-part TV documentary about fabulous animals.
