

Code of Conduct

Anti-harassment and non-discrimination policy

EMBO Courses and Workshops shall maintain an environment free of harassment and discriminatory behaviour for everyone, regardless of gender, gender identity and expression, age, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, ethnicity, beliefs (religious or otherwise) or manner of articulation.
